

Analysis of the political campaign on Twitter

The social network Twitter, which has over 300 million monthly users (MAU) and about 200 million daily users (DAU), is an extremely popular political tool for informing a global audience. For most of the world's politicians, leading political experts, analysts, and journalists, it is considered good form, a natural practice to have a Twitter account. All the major news media, agencies, as well as think-tanks, are actively present on Twitter.

In Belarus, Twitter was named as a source of information only by 11.1% of the male and 5.7% of the female audience, according to the study <u>"Media</u> <u>Consumption During the COVID19 Pandemic"</u>, which was conducted by the Baltic Internet Policy Initiative (BIPI) in August 2021.

The social network Twitter provides a unique opportunity to maintain attention directed to Belarus in the global information agenda. Unlike other social media, where it is possible to buy a number of users - often bots, of course - to increase coverage and create an illusion of widespread influence, social connections, the use of macro and micro influencers are important in twitter. This means that well-known politicians and journalists can have hundreds of thousands and millions of followers - this is a macro level, while many influential experts can have thousands and tens of thousands, and even hundreds of subscribers - but those subscribers can also be influential experts, politicians who listen to the opinions of these experts, journalists who take comments from them. This is a macro-level and it is also important and necessary to work with it.


This post will present the results of the 2021 **#StandWithBelarus** campaign analysis report, obtained using data from TweetBinder.

During the time period from February 3, 2021 to December 25, 2021, there was the following number of tweets with the hashtag **#StandWithBelarus** : 142,068:





Their main driving force is simple social connections between people from the periphery of networking, which until today almost no one thought about.


If social changes do take root in society, then they will happen only there among people who are faced with the same choices and problems that we all face.





In the final part:

The political year 2021 is coming to an end and it is necessary to think about new, fresh political campaigns for 2022. To do this, one needs to carefully research and try to understand the untapped opportunities of this year's campaigns. It's important to understand what practices worked well, but it is strategically even more important to understand what did not work, what campaign mechanics need to be changed and improved. It is recommended to use a wide range of analytical tools so that decisions are based not only and not so much on intuition, but on studies, often possible to be done in real time.

As a result, it would be nice to hope that tapping the possibilities of social networks, accumulated political capital, and the trust of people who believe in new opportunities, will bring long-awaited political changes in Belarus.
